

Solution for 5.1 Untitled (Answer = HARMONICA)

Each picture corresponds to one of the canonical Arthur Conan Doyle Sherlock Holmes stories. The names are anagrams of the titles of these stories, with one letter removed. The idea was to identify the stories, then identify the removed letters, and anagram them to form the word HARMONICA.

The stories were:

A Study in Scarlet

The Adventure of the Cardboard Box

The Five Orange Pips

The Sign of Four

The Valley of Fear

Silver Blaze

The Adventure of the Three Students

The Hound of the Baskervilles

The Adventure of the Creeping Man

If you did not know anything about Sherlock Holmes, you could still figure this out by Googling for some of the more obvious features in the pictures, like "orange", "valley", "cardboard", etc.
