

Solution for 2.2 Poetry (Answer = JABBERWOCK)

Fill in the blank spaces between the two lines by changing one letter at a time from the top word to the bottom word. This gives:

MEWS MEAT BALE SLAPS TEAR

JEWS TEAT BILE CLAPS THAR (or TEAT again)

JAWS THAT BITE CLAWS THAT

JAMS THAN BITS CRAWNS WHAT

JAMB THEN KITS CREWS WHET

The middle line, "JAWS THAT BITE CLAWS THAT" is a (very famous, but Googlable if you don't know it) chunk from Lewis Carroll's Jabberwocky - the creature in question is a Jabberwock.
