"Osbourne" was a reference to Aussie (Ozzy) Rules. Each line of clue gives you two pieces of information. One is an Australian football club, the other a player from that club. Once you have all the players, take the n'th letter of the alphabet corresponding to their guernsey numbers and you should then get AKAAUSTINNJONES. Austinn Jones is an ex-player who played for St Kilda, the only team not in the clues. His nickname was AUSSIE.
