

Solution for 4.4 Congregation (Answer = PRIDE)

This is a "Jigsaw Squares" puzzle where the sets of strings need to be placed into their correct square segment in the right order. The completed arrangement spells out the following phrases:

- RUN NAKED IN PUBLIC
- SHINING WITH BRILLIANT LIGHT
- DISORDERLY CROWD OF PEOPLE
- APPARATUS FOR BOILING WATER
- CLOSELY CROPPED CUT OF HAIR
- COLLOQUIAL NAME FOR SUNGLASSES
- STAR WARS BATTLEFRONT RENEGADE OR ELITE
- UPRIGHT CASE FOR COMPUTER
- JOINING OF MINDS OR SPIRITS
- NEW INFORMATION OR NEWS
- LARGE FORMAL ASSEMBLY
- RIGHT TRIANGULAR PRISM
- PREMEDITATED HOMICIDE
- PREPARE FOR VACATION OR STORAGE
- SON OF PROFESSOR X

These refer to collective nouns that correspond to [AFL teams](#):

- STREAK of tigers (Richmond)
- GLARING of cats (Geelong)
- MOB of kangaroos (North Melbourne)
- KETTLE of hawks (Hawthorn)
- CREW of dockers (Fremantle)
- SHADES of blues (Carlton)
- SQUADRON of bombers (Essendon)
- TOWER of power (Port Adelaide)
- COMMUNION of saints (St Kilda)
- TIDINGS of magpies (Collingwood)
- COVOCATION of eagles (West Coast)
- WEDGE of swans (Sydney)
- MURDER of crows (Adelaide)
- PACK of bulldogs (Western Bulldogs)
- LEGION of demons (Melbourne)

The missing team is Brisbane Lions, for which the collective noun is **PRIDE**.
