

Solution for 3.4 Pocket Monkeys (Answer = BOOMERANG)

The puzzle is set up like a traditional pokemon battle. For each set of two numbers, the first number refers to a particular pokemon, the second a pokemon move known as a TM. Then you fight the two teams of pokemon against each other. Like the game, while the bottom team fights from left to right, the top fights from right to left. In each battle, one pokemon will be vastly superior because of their attack types, hence you can work out the expected winner. Keeping track of the winners, and then taking all the first letters, you get BOOMERANG.

NINETALES wins (Ice is susceptible to Fire)

55 Golduck (WATER), 12 Water Gun (WATER)
