

Hints for 4.4 Congregation

- This puzzle is known as a "Jigsaw Squares" puzzle and consists of fitting each set of strings into its correct square segment. The text that is revealed reading left to right, line by line relates to a group of things (one of which is missing). A black square indicates the end of a word and words do not necessarily end at the end of a line.
- Back in 1996, an additional clue would have been present: "Alternative name for a detective". And back in 1914, the clue "taxonomic group containing one or more orders" would have appeared.
- As a throwback to the puzzle's author, do you know what a collection of plovers is called? Though this would relate to the Warrnambool Rugby Union football team which is the wrong league entirely.
